First semester 2004 sales

CS Group reported consolidated sales for the first semester 2004, € 168 million, down 5%, at constant scope, compared with the first semester 2003. Sales for the second quarter 2004 of € 86,5 million, up 6% compared with the first quarter 2004, is however justified by postponing to the second semester of some projects in the government sector.

From a commercial perspective, the renewal of activity is confirmed. The recovery of organic growth for the second semester will allow the Group to record a 2004 turnover equivalent to 2003.

During this semester, CS has awarded new contracts with the Agence pour le Développement de l'Administration Electronique (ADAE), Banque de Savoie, Délégation Générale pour l'Armement, GIE Cartes Bancaires, Partenord, Peguform, Sofinco, as well as the toll highways in Croatia, Belgium, Chile and California.

CS Group maintains its objectives settled down for 2004 and will present its financial results for the 1st semester 2004 on 6th September 2004.

CS – Chief Executive Officer, Gérard Jousset – is a major player in the design, integration and operation of mission-critical systems, applications and infrastructures. CS is listed on the Premier Marché of the Bourse de Paris and is included in the NextEconomy, MID CAC and IT CAC 50 indices (Euroclear code : 7896).

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
