## First quarter 2004 sales

CS Group reported consolidated sales for the first quarter of 2004 of € 81.5 million, down 3.5% compared with the first quarter of 2003 at constant exchange rates and consolidation scope.

This first quarter was marked by a significant upturn in business, as is evident from the signing of four major international road traffic management contracts (including the design and implementation of a Free Flow system in California worth \$ 16 million), the signing of a framework agreement with UGAP (the French centralised public-sector purchasing body) for network integration solutions on behalf of local authorities, the data migration work carried out for the Banque de Savoie and the Linux conversion of billing applications for ATMB, the joint operator of the Mont Blanc tunnel.

Order intake for the quarter was higher than in the same period last year.

The Annual General Meeting is to be held on 28 May 2004.
